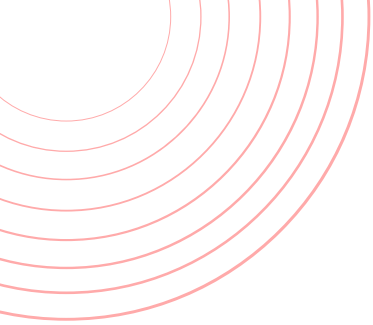

We value the process & progression and we believe firmly in ballet being the foundation for all dance. We strongly suggest each dancer start in ballet and then add tumbling at age 5, tap at age 6, jazz at age 7, and hip hop and contemporary at age 8.

Our main goal is to help the dancers learn more about their specific form of dance. But in addition,

- we want them to realize the art, culture, and heritage of their chosen form
- to achieve a disciplined attitude
- to have more self awareness
- to know self-discipline, physical development, & achievement go hand in hand
- to find & obtain the joy for music & movement

We look forward to a new year of classes, new friends, new skills learned, as well as our Production Recital in June 8, 2024, Studio Dance Theatre, Dance Arts Performing CORE and Imagine Worship events.
