# **Dress** Code

For your convenience, all equipment may be ordered & purchased at the studio at a cost effective price point. We prefer students purchase the items with us so that everyone will match at performance time!

All female Ballet students are required to wear a leotard, pink tights and pink ballet slippers.

- > Tiny Tots, Pre-Dance, and Beginning students are to wear Royal Blue
- > Ballet I-III & Elementary students are to wear Royal Blue
- > Inter I & II Ballet students are to wear Light Blue
- > Inter III & IV Ballet students are to wear Light Pink
- > Advanced ballet students are to wear Black

Legwarmers, wrap sweaters, elastics, skirts (pointe only) and knee pads (jazz) are optional equipment and may be used but not abused! T-Shirts, crop tops & socks are not acceptable dancewear and are prohibited.

Jazz and Tap students are to wear black leotard & black shorts & tan jazz or black tap shoes which are available at registration Tumbling students are to wear black leotard & black shorts which are available at registration Contemporary students are to wear black leotard & black shorts with skin color half sole shoes which are available at registration Hip Hop students are to wear a tight fitting tank top,

black pants, & black hip hop shoes, available at registration

Male Students - Navy or black shorts, White solid color T-Shirt, White Socks, and Black Shoes or appropriate dancewear. All other classes may wear any color leotard, but should check with their instructor for tights, pants & shoes.

# littion

There are a total of 36 classes during the year, breaking into 8 payments. Payments for tuition will be at Registration, then monthly from October-March. April & May payments will be paid together. Our session goes for the length of the school year, September 9, 2024-June 5th, 2025. Payment is due by the 5th of each month. Cash/check is preferred. You may also sign up for auto-pay or make online payments through the parent portal on our website. There will be a credit card processing fee if payment is made online.

A \$20.00 late fee will be added to unpaid accounts after the 15th of each month. Tuition is non-refundable. Any classes missed, are to be made up in another class within 6 weeks. To change your method of enrollment, you must drop the class online and notify the office by the 1st of the month. Classes under 5 students fall to semi-private tuition. Class changes after the 1st 6 weeks - \$10.00 charge.

Tuition is based on how many hours of dance in a week. This number is based on anyone dancing in the same family. (ie: The Johnson's have a daughter and a son and they take two, 1 hour classes each for a total of 4 hours in a week) Prices below include a 10% discount for 2 classes taken, 15% for the 3rd class, 20% for the 4th and beyond.
