Reminder

The weeks are flying by. As per our student handbook and brochure, your April and May tuition are due April 5th. We take no payments for tuition in May (unless you've already spoken to us). Please prepare for this and thank you for helping us wrap up the season not with billing and finances but fun choreography and excitement about the upcoming recital.

- At-Home Practice--To ensure that the students feel confident about their performance, we ask
 parents and guardians to encourage them to rehearse their recital choreography on a regular basis.

 your teacher for additional guestions.
- **Clean Dance Wear**--Please see that your dancer has clean tights and shoes for our June Recital. If you need to order anything please order on your parent portal or stop into the front office.
- **Costume Fee**--In order to costume each student and clean the costume, for Mini Recitals you rent a costume from our collection. In some cases we need to purchase additional items. Each dancer for each class will have a **\$5 costume rental** charge for this. It is a nominal fee but we want to make sure that each dancer has something fun and different to wear that makes sense with their recital piece. This **\$5** costume rental fee is due *March 10th*.
- Recital Package Fee--Did you know there are no tickets costs for our Mini Recitals? However we will be charging \$12/student for your recital package which includes your 3 tickets, sets and props for your recital dance, and a digital download for the entire show. This will be billed out March 10th. Thank you for your participation in recital! It will be so much fun!
- Day of Mini Recital--- Each student is allowed to bring 3 guests to each recital. This doesn't include the dancer as they will be in studio B. Please start figuring out who is coming to see you shine on stage!
- **Pre Planning**----The recital isn't a one-day activity. You might be performing multiple times during our Mini Recital Week. Please note there is no food allowed in the dressing room and no eating in costume. There is to be no food around any costume so please eat before you come. Please gather all shoes and tights in advance so you'll know if something is missing or isn't right. All dancers for Mini Recital need red lipstick. Other make up is up to each parent/family/dancer. It doesn't hurt to have a backstage bag with other things like safety pins, a needle and thread the color of their costume (already threaded helps in time of emergencies). Handy extras are baby wipes, baby powder, a pain reliever of your choice, band-aids, extra tights, instant ice pack, and clear nail polish for emergency runs in tights. It is a good idea to have something quiet to do backstage (book to read or coloring book...etc) Dance Arts will not be responsible for electronic equipment-leave all valuables at home. There is to be no jewelry worn at Mini Recital so please leave all of that at home as well. Thank you for your cooperation in helping us and your dancer have a celebration during recital week!
